

ORDER YOUR 2011 UPDATE TO

THE CALIFORNIA LAW *Governing* CEMETERIES FUNERAL DIRECTORS CORONERS

2011 CUMULATIVE SUPPLEMENT TO THE 2008 MAIN VOLUME

THE 2011 CMAC LAW BOOK CUMULATIVE UPDATE CONTAINS A TOTAL OF 119 LAWS, SET FORTH IN TWELVE DIFFERENT STATE CODES. THESE 119 LAWS ARE NOT CONTAINED IN THE 2008 MAIN VOLUME, NOR ARE THEY CONTAINED IN THE 2009 OR 2010 ANNUAL SUPPLEMENTS. THE LAWS IN THIS YEAR'S SUPPLEMENT INCLUDE:

- Authorization for counties to designate veterans and their organizations for the interment of veterans and their spouses.
- Authority for family members and other loved ones to use keepsake urns to hold small portions of the cremated remains.
- Requirement that a disposition permit be obtained for each keepsake urn.
- Revisions to the laws pertaining to the California Central Coast Veterans Cemetery at Fort Ord.
- Separate authorizations for specific counties to increase the fees charged for death records.
- Authority for the Elsinore Valley Cemetery District to inter nonresidents.
- Repeal of an obsolete provision of law stating that a crematory must be associated with a columbarium, burial park, or mausoleum.
- Requirement that each identification disk, tab, or label contain the license number of the crematory and a unique number .
- Revisions to the laws enabling individuals whose licenses have expired while on active duty to reinstate their licenses without penalty or examination.
- Amendments to the laws providing that court-imposed restitution for injuring historic burial grounds can include the costs to re-inter the remains.
- Amendments to the laws pertaining to the confidentiality of licensee records regarding alcohol or drug treatment.
